 aged 45 years, do declare on oath that my personal description is:
 sex male, color white, complexion medium, color of eyes blue
 color of hair dark brown-gray, height 5 feet 6 inches; weight 192 pounds; visible distinctive marks
Scar on left index finger.

I am of the nationality Polish
 born in Lublin, Poland, on April 20, 1891
 married. The name of my wife or husband is Antonina Lejwoda
 we were married on Feb. 2, 1915 at South Framingham, Mass.; she or he was
 born in Lublin, Poland, on April 25, 1891, entered the United States
New York, N.Y., on Oct. 20, 1915, for permanent residence therein, and now
 resides at Worcester, Mass. I have seven children, and the name and place of birth,
 of each of said children are as follows: Stefan, Jan. 22, 1914; Bronislawa, Oct. 15, 1915; Wacław, Aug. 15, 1917; Edward, Dec. 17, 1919; Helena, Mar. 15, 1922; Wlodek, Jun. 4, 1925; Ryanard, Feb. 24, 1928; all born and now living at Worcester, Mass.

I have heretofore made a declaration of intention: Number 24754, on Dec. 18, 1921

 my last foreign residence was Braclawiska, Poland
 I emigrated to the United States of America from Antwerp, Belgium
 my lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was at New York, N.Y.
 under the name of Stanislaw Markiewicz, on May 20, 1912
 the vessel SS Zealand.

I will, before being admitted to citizenship, renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly, by name, to the prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty of which I may be at the time of my admission a citizen or subject; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to reside permanently therein; and I certify that the photograph affixed to the duplicate and triplicate hereof is a likeness of me: **SO HELP ME GOD.**
