**DECLARATION OF INTENTION**  
(Invalid for all purposes seven years after the date hereof)

**Commonwealth of Massachusetts** | In the Superior Court  
SS: County of Worcester of Massachusetts at Worcester, Mass.

I, Stanislaw Markiewicz, residing at 230 Hillside Ave., Worcester, Mass., aged 45 years, do declare on oath that my personal description is: male, color white, complexion medium, color of eyes blue, hair dark brown-grey, height 5 feet 6 inches; weight 192 pounds; visible distinctive marks Scar on left index finger.

Polish; nationality Polish. Was born in Lublin, Poland, on April 20, 1891. Married. The name of my wife or husband is Antonina Lejwoda. Were married on Feb. 2, 1913, at South Framingham, Mass.; she or he was born at Lublin, Poland, on Oct. 20, 1891, entered the United States at New York, N.Y., on Oct. 20, 1912, for permanent residence therein, and now resides at Worcester, Mass.. I have seven children, and the name, date and place of birth, place of residence of each of said children are as follows: Stanislaw, Jan. 22, 1914; Boleslaw, Oct. 1915; Halina, Aug. 15, 1917; Elzbieta, Dec. 17, 1919; Helena, Mar. 15, 1922; Anna, Jun. 4, 1925; Edward, Feb. 24, 1928; all born and now living at Worcester, Mass.

We heretofore made a declaration of intention: Number 24724, on Dec. 16, 1921 at Worcester, Mass. Superior Court. Last foreign residence was Breslau, Poland. Migrated to the United States from Anvers, Belgium. Lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was at New York, N.Y. Under the name of Stanislaw Markiewicz, on May 20, 1912. (Other than by vessel state manner of arrival)

I will, before being admitted to citizenship, renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly, by name, to the prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty of which I may be at the time admission a citizen or subject; I am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to reside permanently therein; and I certify that the photograph affixed to the duplicate and triplicate hereof is a likeness of me: So HELP ME GOD.


